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Vinegar Hill, Milford on Sea, Hampshire

Located in the peaceful coastal village of Milford on Sea, near the New Forest, Vinegar Hill is a B&B with a difference; it doubles as a pottery school. The accommodation is far from your average seaside B&B, and guests can even stay in Rosie, the beautifully-restored 19th-century gypsy wagon. Run by acclaimed potter Dave Rogers and his wife Lucy, Vinegar Hill offers one- and three-day courses throughout the year, which include home-cooked lunches, not to mention plenty of tea and cake. *From £80 per night*
